This film series is held with the generous support of the Ambler Theater and other local businesses.

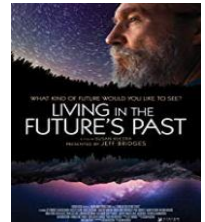
Doors open at 6 p.m. for the Sponsor Expo in the lobby of the theater. Films start at 7:30 p.m.

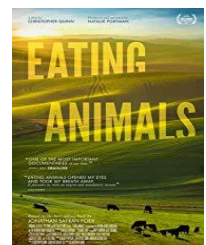
Tuesday, March 26 – Food for Change
